1	Electric shock	Computer, Amplifier, Electrical Equipment	Presenter and volunteers from audience	all equipment pad tested	none required
2	Shock to hearing	amplified music	Presenter and audience	Speakers positioned carefully and sound checked before start of performance	none required
3	Electric shock	Water used for alcopop demonstration	Presenter and volunteer from audience	Water must be positioned well away from electrical equipment and at a distance so that splashes do not hit equipment	none required
4	Alcohol	alcopop used in demonstration	Volunteer	control amount of alcohol consumed	none required
5	Eye damage	UV lamp	Presenter and audience	Do not shine light in the eyes of anyone person for a prolonged period of time	none required
6	Trip Hazard	Dancing on stage	Presenter and volunteers from audience	Carefully position volunteers when they come onto the stage	none required
7	Offence	Condom Science	Audience	Give verbal warning about the contents of that section of the talk and ask people not too look and listen. Also give 15 or over warning on advertising	none required
8	Respiratory problems	Boar Mate Pheromone Spray	Audience	Spray pheromone into the air above peoples heads and not directly at peoples faces	none required
